Safe Environment Program

The mission of our diocesan Safe Environment Program is to insure the safety of children, young people, and vulnerable adults who have been entrusted to our care in our parishes, schools, religious education classes, and other programs. Volunteers 18 years of age and older who serve in a parish ministry or program in a position of authority, trust, or supervision involving contact with minor children or vulnerable adults must maintain the following:

- Current Safe Environment (Youth) certification or current Vulnerable Adult Ministry (VAM) certification
- Current background check, completed through the Diocese of Owensboro.

Safe Environment training may be completed online; visit www.stmore.org and click on the Safe Environment Program link. Vulnerable Adult Ministry training is provided at the Parish Office.
