

St. Gabriel Chapels Usage Policy

St. Gabriel Parish celebrates its liturgies and sacraments at its home church on 1200 St. Gabriel Way.

The St. Gabriel Chapels (St. Hubert and The Maternity of the Blessed Virgin MMY (herein “St. Mary”)) may be used, by way of exception, for weddings and funerals by any parishioner (or child of a parishioner) who was a registered member of the respective chapel congregation (St. Hubert or St. Mary) prior to the merger of St. Columba, St. Hubert and St. Mary into St. Gabriel Congregation. The registered parishioner (or child of a registered parishioner) authorized to use the chapel for weddings and/or funerals is responsible for the cleaning and preparation of the chapel prior to use. The authorized parishioner may request St. Gabriel Parish to assist in cleaning of the requested chapel and St. Gabriel Parish may assist in or arrange cleaning at the authorized parishioner’s expense. An additional fee of \$200 will be assessed for the set up and restoration of the chapel for the requested use.

Authorization to use the St. Gabriel Parish Chapels is made by the St. Gabriel Pastor or Administrator. Use may be restricted during winter months if the weather does not permit winterization. This policy may be rescinded at any time if the St. Gabriel Parish Pastor or Administrator determines the condition of one or both of our chapels to be unsafe for funerals or weddings.
