PASTOR'S NOTES

Where is God?.....Just a few weeks ago I was with the youth of the parish on Saturday evening for their Mass and penitential service. It was the second time in two weeks that I was with them. (We had two Confirmation retreats because we have so many youth). In my talk on the Lordship of Jesus, before we began the Mass and penitential service, I told them that accepting Jesus as the Lord of their life was NOT about feeling “warm fuzzies” inside. The reason that I did this was because so many of us (me included) are looking for Jesus to make us feel good. We want to get a “free pass” from the pain and struggle in life. Or to put it another way, we are often looking for a “rose garden”. Many of the youth of our parish (not all) have a great deal of pain in their lives. Some of the pain has come as a result of their own poor choices. But some of the pain is the result of living in very dysfunctional families. Jesus is not the “silver bullet” or the “quick fix” for all the pain in life. Jesus isn’t a pill that we take and then magically, all the sorrow, pain, and disorder in life disappear. Maybe this happens in Camelot, but in my 56 (almost 57) years of life I have not found this to be true. So what good is Jesus, and where is God when we are in pain? The crucifixion tells us clearly and simply that God is willing to suffer with, for, and in us. To put it another way, when we suffer, God is suffering in and with us. The crucifixion is the ultimate promise of God that no one, anywhere, suffers alone, and no suffering can separate us from God. Does God want us to suffer? I do not think so! God cannot eliminate all suffering in the world, but God can be with us in the midst of all our suffering. So what good is Jesus? Jesus loves us so much that he forgoes the comfortable life of heaven to be with us and suffer with us. In other words, Jesus has a “heart” for the one who is suffering. Secondly, when we follow Jesus; that is, when we take His way seriously becoming His disciples, we learn a way that leads us away from much of the pain in the world that comes from dysfunctional living. (I would guess that this is the largest cause of pain in our world – just my opinion). As we learn the way of sacrificial love, we learn how to live in healthier and more loving relationship. Living “in” Christ does not protect us from all pain; however, we stop inflicting so much pain on ourselves and others. Sometimes we talk (“churchy talk”) as if Jesus were Santa Claus who

magically steers us clear of all difficulty in life. Watch yourself the next time you pray spontaneously and see if your prayer doesn’t betray this tendency. This can lead others to conclude that “we” are running from reality and worshipping a God who does NOT deliver. As I talk with more and more people, I am convinced that as Scott Peck has asserted, all neurosis comes from our desire to avoid pain. Look at Jesus, he did NOT avoid pain. He accepted it because of LOVE. To me, this Jesus is someone worth following. A Jesus who is with me in the midst of my pain, and who teaches me the way of sacrificial love, is a Jesus who is worthy of my admiration and adoration! Our Lenten journey is to open ourselves to this Jesus and let him lead our lives. Have a blessed Lent!

St. Francis has received the City of Vista's comments from the second plan check and we are quickly responding to their concerns. The good news is that at present there appears to be nothing major to address.

At this point, we hope to be able to go out to bid soon so that we can determine if the cost estimates that we have previously obtained are still accurate. If the overall price for Phase 1a, holds then we will be able to approach the Diocese for permission to move forward with a contract to the low bidder.

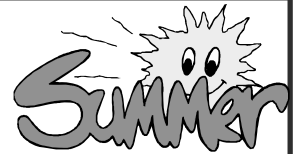
Fr. Ramón Marrufo's Anniversary

TÌM HIỂU MÙA CHAY, TUẦN THÁNH & MÙA PHỤC SINH

► **Mùa Chay là gì ?** Mùa Chay là mùa sám hối đặc biệt để chuẩn bị mừng lễ Vượt Qua (cuộc khổ hình, tử nạn và sống lại) của Đức Kitô để cứu chuộc nhân loại. Mùa Chay là thời gian luyện tập đức tin của các tín hữu được thêm vững mạnh. Mùa Chay còn chuẩn bị cho anh chị em dự tòng đón nhận sự sống thiêng liêng nhờ việc sống tinh thân bí tích Thánh Tẩy.

► **Mùa Chay kéo dài bao nhiêu ngày ?** Mùa Chay kéo dài 40 ngày, gồm 6 Chúa Nhật, khởi đầu từ Thứ tư Lễ Tro và kết thúc trước thánh lễ Tiệc Ly chiều Thứ năm Tuần Thánh.

► **Việc xúc tro mang ý nghĩa gì ?** Việc xúc tro nhắc nhở người Kitô hữu ý thức về thân phận thụ tạo mỏng dòn yếu đuối chóng qua, vì thế phải sống với thái độ khiêm tốn trước mặt Chúa để nhận ra và sám hối về những lầm lỗi thiếu sót của mình. Khi xúc tro thừa tác viên đọc "Hãy ăn năn sám hối và tin vào Tin Mừng."

► **Những phương thế Giáo hội thường dùng trong Mùa Chay thánh là gì ?** SÁM HỐI, ĂN CHAY, CẦU NGUYỆN, VIỆC LÀM BÁC ÁI.

► **Thế nào là sám hối ?** Sám hối là can đảm và khiêm tốn nhìn nhận những lỗi lầm mình đã phạm và quyết tâm sửa đổi cuộc đời.

► **Thế nào là ăn chay ?** Chỉ ăn một bữa no, và có thể ăn nhẹ, lót dạ vào bữa sáng và bữa tối không ăn vặt (kẹo, bánh, trái cây, chè) và không được giải khát bằng nước ngọt, bia, rượu, café.

► **Người ăn chay phải có tinh thần gì ?** Người ăn chay phải có tinh thần bác ái, chia sẻ, giúp đỡ những người túng thiếu, nghèo đói.

► **Theo luật Giáo hội, người tín hữu tuổi nào buộc giữ chay và kiêng thịt ?** Mọi người từ tuổi trưởng thành, tức là 14 tuổi trọn cho đến khi bắt đầu 60 tuổi thì buộc giữ chay. Còn luật kiêng thịt thì từ 14 tuổi trọn trở lên.

► **Trong Mùa Chay, Hội Thánh buộc người tín hữu giữ chay và kiêng thịt vào những ngày nào ?** Trong Mùa Chay, Hội Thánh buộc người tín hữu giữ chay và kiêng thịt trong hai ngày là Thứ tư lễ Tro và Thứ sáu tuần thánh.

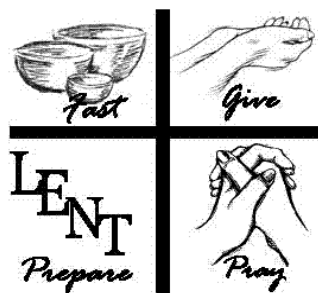
► **Thế nào là kiêng thịt (kiêng heo, bò, gà... được phép ăn tôm, cá, trứng ...)** Ngày xưa ăn chay kiêng thịt là một việc thiết thực, ngày nay mang tính biểu tượng nhiều hơn, ý nghĩa của việc kiêng thịt là nhắc nhở người tín hữu phải chế ngự và làm chủ các ham muốn bản thân.

► **Tuần lễ nào là cao điểm của Mùa Chay và của cả năm Phụng vụ ?** Tuần lễ thánh bắt đầu bằng Chúa Nhật lễ Lá.

► **Chúa Nhật lễ Lá, Hội Thánh tưởng niệm biến cố gì ?** Chúa Nhật lễ Lá, Hội Thánh kỷ niệm biến cố Chúa Giêsu long trọng vào thành Giêrusalem để hoàn tất chương trình cứu chuộc của Thiên Chúa.

► **Lá đã được làm phép trong lễ Lá được lưu giữ lại tại mỗi gia đình nhắc nhở điều gì ?** Lá đó nhắc nhở chúng ta về Chúa Kitô vinh thắng.

► **Cử hành thánh lễ trong Mùa Chay và Mùa Phục sinh khác nhau ở điểm nào ?**



Mùa Chay : Không đọc kinh Vinh Danh / Không đệm đàn khi không có tiếng hát / Không đọc hoặc hát Allêluia / Không trưng bông trên bàn thờ / Chủ tế mặc áo tím .

Mùa Phục Sinh : Đọc kinh Vinh Danh / Được đệm đàn khi không có tiếng hát / Đọc hoặc hát Allêluia / Được trưng bông trên bàn thờ / Chủ tế mặc áo trắng.

Tiếp tục Tuần Sau : Tuần Thánh ...

Mensaje del Párroco

¿Dónde está Dios?.....Hace unas semanas estaba con los jóvenes de la parroquia, un sábado por la tarde, durante su Misa y servicio Penitencial. Era la segunda vez en dos semanas que había estado con ellos (2 Retiros de Confirmación porque eran muchos jóvenes). En mi plática sobre el Señorío de Jesús, antes que comenzara la Misa y el servicio Penitencial, les dije que el aceptar a Jesús como el Señor de sus vidas NO era algo que ellos solo sintieran por dentro. La razón por lo que hice esto fue porque muchos de nosotros (incluyéndome) buscamos a Jesús para que nos sintamos bien. Queremos un “boleto gratis” para no enfrentar el dolor o las batallas de la vida. Diciéndolo de otra manera, con frecuencia solo buscamos “un jardín de rosas”. Muchos de los jóvenes de nuestra parroquia (no todos) llevan una gran carga en sus vidas. Algunos de sus dolores vienen a consecuencia de sus decisiones erróneas. Pero algunos de los dolores son el resultado de vivir dentro de familias disfuncionales (incompletas). Jesús no es la “bala de plata” que “de inmediato” quita el dolor de la vida. Jesús no es una pastilla que al tomarse, mágicamente, todo sufrimiento, dolor y desorden en la vida, desaparecen. Quizás esto suceda en Camelot (mundo de fantasía), pero a mis 56 años, casi 57, sé muy bien que es una verdad. Así que ¿dónde está el bueno de Jesús o Dios cuando estoy lleno de dolor? La crucifixión nos dice claro y simplemente que Dios desea sufrir con, por y en nosotros. Diciéndolo de otra forma, cuando sufrimos, Dios sufre en y con nosotros. La crucifixión es la promesa última de Dios que ninguno, en ningún lugar, alguien sufre solo, y ningún sufrimiento puede separarnos de Dios. ¿Dios desea que suframos? ¡No lo creo! Dios no puede eliminar todo el sufrimiento del mundo, pero, Dios puede estar con nosotros en medio de todo nuestro sufrimiento. ¿Qué tan bueno es Jesús? Jesús nos ama tanto que olvida la vida cómoda del cielo para estar con nosotros y sufrir con nosotros. En otras palabras, Jesús tiene “un corazón” para aquel que está sufriendo. Segundo, cuando seguimos a Jesús, esto es, cuando tomamos su camino seriamente, llegando a ser sus discípulos conocemos un camino que nos conduce a alejarnos del dolor del mundo que viene por vivir disfuncionalmente (adivino que esta es la causa mayor del dolor en nuestro mundo —es sólo mi opinión). Solo cuando aprendamos el camino del amor lleno de sacrificio, aprenderemos cómo vivir una relación sana y amorosa. Vivir “en” Cristo no nos protege de todo

dolor, sin embargo, detenemos el dolor que nos aflige y hace sufrir a otros. Algunas veces, hablamos (“platicas de iglesia”) como si Jesús fuera Santa Claus que mágicamente puede quitarnos todas las dificultades de la vida. Mírense ustedes mismos, la próxima vez que hagan espontáneamente oración y vean si su oración no traiciona esta tendencia. Esto puede llevar a otros a concluir que “nosotros” estamos huyendo de la realidad y que damos culto a un Dios que NO responde. 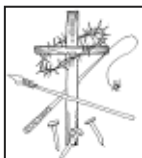
