| ✓ | Ministry   | Description   |
|---|--|---|
|   | <b><i>Altar Server - Adult</i></b>                                     | Needed for daily Mass – you pick the day. Some training required.   |
|   | <b><i>Altar Server - Youth</i></b>                                     | Must be 4 <sup>th</sup> grade or older. Serves approx. 1 time a month. 2 hour training (in the fall) required.  |
|   | <b><i>Altar Server Alb Washer</i></b>                                  | Wash Altar Server robes once a month and return them to the church office.  |
|   | <b><i>Catechists - Religious Education</i></b>                         | Teach from curriculum provided books to the children of our parish. Requires 3-4 planning time and weekly classroom time. Training available. Fingerprinting, Safe Environment Training and Adult Continuing Education is required. |
|   | <b><i>Eucharistic Ministers (EM)</i></b>                               | Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion. Must be trained & commissioned at Ss. Peter & Paul.   |
|   | ○ <i>Daily Mass</i>  | You pick a preferred day. Church provides guide book. Requires priest consultation. Must be commissioned at Mass. Training Required.  |
|   | ○ <i>Saturday/ Sunday Mass</i>   | Same as above. Sign up available at each Mass.  |
|   | ○ <i>Hospital</i>  | Same as above. Take Holy Communion to Patients at Blake 2 times a month.  |
|   | ○ <i>Homebound and/or Nursing Home</i>                                 | Same as above and must be fingerprinted and go through Safe Environment training (Homebound only). Take Holy Communion to homebound and/or Nursing Homes as needed.   |
|   | <b><i>Lectors - Readers at Mass Daily and/or Saturdays/Sundays</i></b> | Read the New/Old Testament at a Mass – Practice at home. Will be trained by a seasoned parish lector. Flexible Schedule.  |
|   | <b><i>Music Ministries</i></b>   | <b>Music ministry spreads the word of Jesus Christ through song and instruments.</b>  |
|   | ○ <i>Adult Choir</i>   | Wed. rehearsals from 7-8:30pm. Sings for 9:30am Mass and for Christmas and Easter.  |
|   | ○ <i>Folk Choir</i>  | Tues. evening rehearsals from 7-8:30pm. Sings at 11:30am Mass on Sundays.   |
|   | ○ <i>Adult Handbell Choir</i>  | Must be able to read music. Wed. rehearsals from 1-2pm. Plays at 4:30pm Mass on the 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> Sat. of each month.   |
|   | ○ <i>Youth Handbell Choir</i>  | Must be in 4 <sup>th</sup> grade or above. Fri. rehearsals from 4:30-5:30pm.  |

|  | <b><i>Good Samaritans</i></b>                     | Help take homebound to Mass, Drs appts. and more  |
|  | <b><i>Sacristans Daily or Saturday/Sunday</i></b> | Person charged with the care of the setting up for Mass, assisting the priest and cleaning up after Mass. You pick your Mass of choice. Weekly or Daily commitment. Training Required. Must be a Ss. Peter and Paul EM. |
|  | ○ Funeral Mass                                    | Sacristan for funeral Masses. Flexible schedule required. Training required.  |
|  | <b><i>Religious Articles Store</i></b>            | Requires 15 -20 minutes after Mass of your choice. Some training required.  |
|  | <b><i>Ushers</i></b>                              | Volunteer weekly Saturdays/Sundays to welcome people, Collect offertory baskets and help seat people at Mass. Requirements: Must be age 16 or older be personable. Guideline available. Some training.                  |

|  | <b>Parish Events</b>                      | <b>Description</b>   |

|  | <b><i>Parish Picnic/Craft Show</i></b>    | 1 -2 days – usual in the first part of November. Help set up, clean up and coordinate picnic events.   |
|  | <b><i>Christmas Dinner Dance</i></b>      | Help with decorations, set up, serving and clean up. 1 time a year.  |
|  | <b><i>Catholic Cafe</i></b>               | Help set up, serve, cook and/or clean up for our quarterly sausage and egg breakfasts.   |
|  | <b><i>Lenten Fish Fry(s)</i></b>          | Help serve at 2 Fridays during Lent.   |
|  | <b><i>Santa Sunday</i></b>                | Help serve donuts/milk/coffee to children under 8 and their families – 1 Sunday in December.   |
|  | <b><i>New Parishioner Sunday</i></b>      | Welcome and meet new parish members. Help serve breakfast on last Sunday of January.   |
|  | <b><i>Migrant Food Drive</i></b>          | Help collect, pack and transport food to St. Vincent DePaul. Limited volunteers needed. Spanish helpful.   |
|  | <b><i>Rosary Makers</i></b>               | Meets once a week to make rosaries for the poor and those in different countries.  |
|  | <b><i>SOLVE Rummage Sale</i></b>          | Help with a HUGE rummage sale in our Parish Ctr. to benefit SOLVE maternity home. 3-4 days in July.  |
|  | <b><i>Ticket Sales Committee</i></b>      | Sell tickets to misc. church events after Mass. Flexible schedule.   |
|  | <b><i>Vacation Bible School (VBS)</i></b> | 1-2 week commitment in June. Volunteers needed to teach, set up and/or clean up.   |
|  | <b><i>St. Vincent DePaul Society</i></b>  | The Society of St. Vincent de Paul welcomes "all who wish to live their faith by loving and serving their neighbor." Located in the Activity Center. |
|  | <b><i>Youth Ministry</i></b>              | Provide snacks and/or 2 liter sodas two times a month for Youth Group Meetings on Sunday or Wednesday.   |
