Start bringing them JULY 25th! Many of these children have families that struggle financially. The school supplies/backpacks we give them are the ONLY school supplies they will receive when they return to school this Fall!

5) I was shocked to learn that former State Senator WOODS BOWMAN was killed in a car crash last weekend! WOODS was a great friend and supporter of deaf people. When WOODS was a State Senator, he helped get laws passed re: mental health and deaf persons, child protection and deaf persons. Please pray for his wife MICHELLE who was badly injured in the crash.

6) Live in Chicago? Someone in your home is deaf, disabled, mentally ill, old and cannot walk? The City of Chicago wants you to register this information. Then, if the FIRE DEPT or POLICE come to your home/apt, they will know what to expect. The information is confidential, only for emergency services: www.cityofchicago.org/voluntaryregistry
