Become very sick: high fever, chills, throwing up, diarrhea won't stop? Call 9-1-1 for help! Deaf? Dial 9-1-1: do NOT hang up/ leave phone off receiver.

SOME NOTES FROM FR. JOE:

1) I am out of town 1/13-20 attending the NCOD (National Catholic Office of the Deaf) "Pastoral Week". If there is an emergency or funeral, contact the Catholic Office of the Deaf immediately!

2) ARCHBISHOP CUPICH is travelling around the Archdiocese to celebrate Masses in various Vicariates (there are six Vicariates in the Archdiocese). If you are deaf and wish to attend one of these Masses (listed on the other page), you need a ticket. Contact the Catholic Office of the Deaf so we can put you on the list to get into the Masses. All of these Vicariate Masses will be interpreted.

3) GUNS & GUN SAFETY: maybe you read the story about a 2 year old boy who accidentally shot his mother. The boy reached into the mother's purse, found her gun, and pulled the trigger. The mom died. I do not understand why the mother would put the gun into her purse without putting the safety on the weapon.

In Illinois, people are allowed to carry guns. However, they must have a FOID (Firearm Owner ID card). If a person does not have that card and the police find a gun, rifle, etc, that person will go to jail. If you own a gun, children must NEVER be allowed near that gun.

4) The FLU season is getting worse. If you become sick, please stay home and rest. If you become VERY sick, call 9-1-1.

5) Please make sure you get your CHURCH ENVELOPES. This is the best way to support St. Francis Borgia Deaf Center. We will send out before the end of January, a tax letter to anyone who used their Church envelopes in 2014.

6) The AFFORDABLE HEALTH CARE ACT (Obamacare). If you wish to have health insurance starting February 1, you have to sign up by JANUARY 15TH.
