7) Illinois CARE Act. Since January 1, 2016, there is a new law in Illinois, the Caregiver Advise, Record, Enable (CARE) Act. The law says that if a person is in the hospital, that person can choose someone to be their “caregiver”. That means the hospital MUST talk with the caregiver and teach that caregiver how to do things such as manage medications, injections, wound care and home health care. IF the caregiver is deaf, the hospital must provide a sign-language interpreter for that training.
