3) What is HIPPA? HIPPA (Hospital Information Patient Protection Act) is a federal law. The law does NOT allow hospitals to give out ANY patient information without the patient's permission. This means if I (Fr. Joe) call the hospital to find out how a patient is doing, the nurse or doctor CANNOT tell me anything unless you gave them permission.
