SOME NOTES FROM FR. JOE:

1) PALMS & HOLY WATER BOTTLES! Next Sunday, we will bless palms and give them to all who come to Church. If you have old palms at home, crumple them up and spread them in your garden. If you have holy water in your bottle at home, do NOT pour the water into your sink. Pour it on your plants, lawn, or garden. Then, bring that bottle with you for either HOLY SATURDAY NIGHT or EASTER SUNDAY morning Masses.

2) As we approach Palm Sunday, Holy Week, Easter, the BIBLE Readings (other side) each day help us prepare for these holy days. Take time EACH DAY to read your Bible.

3) Do you know someone who has not been to Church? INVITE that person to join us, especially for Palm Sunday and Easter. Let that person know that he/she is welcome at St. Francis Borgia.

4) Each year, we have a wonderful custom on HOLY THURSDAY(4/2) evening, our “Bread & Wine” Social. We ask people to bring bread – home-made, fresh. We supply cheese, butter, jelly, coffee, and wine! We do this after the 7pm Mass. It is FREE. Sign-up today to let us know what you will bring that evening. You can also bring fresh fruit!
