2) Why do we have the HAWTHORNE RACE? The CATHOLIC OFFICE of the DEAF provides services for deaf and hard of hearing persons and their families all over the Chicago metropolitan area. The Archdiocese of Chicago provides HALF (50%) of the Office's budget. Fr. Joe has to raise the OTHER 50%. The horse race gives us a profit each year of \$30,000+. This is a big chunk of the budget! Without the Hawthorne Event, the Catholic Office of the deaf will have to stop providing sign-language interpreters for individuals and families, stop sending out mailings and announcements about deaf events.

3) Recently, I (Fr. Joe) received a call from the U.S. Justice Department in Washington, DC. The lawyer from the Department wanted to talk with me re: deaf people and police officers. I suggested to the lawyer that the Justice Department should have a meeting with deaf people to learn from YOU about how to improve relationships between police and the deaf community. The Justice Dept. will work on this. If you have had ANY experiences as a deaf person with the police, you need to let the government know about how to improve police-deaf services. I will let you know more information re: future meetings.

4) ROME 2018: I (Fr. Joe) will meet with our travel agent (Nancy Scorby) soon to plan for the trip to meet Pope Francis in June 2018. Basically, we will leave Chicago June 24, 2018 to arrive in Rome 6/25. JUNE 26 & 27, we will meet with other deaf folks from the world, have a special Mass in St. Peter's, then meet Pope Francis on 6/28. 6/29, we will travel to southern Italy, and then to Sicily. Returning to Chgo 7/6 or 7, 2018. More details to follow.
