2) MFP is Ministry Formation program for Deaf persons. MFP is a four year program that trains deaf people to work in the Church. People meet six (6) weekends/year in Mundelein, IL. MFP is an excellent way for deaf people to learn new skills in the Catholic faith. If you are a Catholic deaf person (or hearing person with good sign-language skills), you can join MFP. If you live in the Archdiocese of Chicago, the Catholic Office of the deaf will pay your full tuition. Talk with Fr. Joe Mulcrone if you are interested.
