SOME NOTES from FR. JOE:

1) This week, I am at the NCOD (National Catholic Office of the Deaf) Pastoral Week. I am presenting two workshops on “Health Care & Pastoral Workers”.

2) TWO IMPORTANT DATES:

- JAN. 22: this is a sad anniversary. In 1973, the Supreme Court allowed abortion to be legal in our country. Since then, we have had millions of unborn children die because of abortion. Also, years later, many women who had abortions grieve because they realize they destroyed the life of their own child. Pray for these women. At the same time, we must work hard to make sure ALL children have enough to eat, can get a good education, and are safe from abuse and violence.
- JAN. 24: The feast of ST. FRANCIS DE SALES, the patron saint of deaf people. Take a close look at the painting of St. Francis in the front of our chapel. PATRICIA SLISZ did that painting and donated it to the chapel.

3) SWOBODA CENTER. We will remain here at St. Francis Borgia Deaf Center for Masses and Socials. Now we have space we can use for meetings, socials, workshops, other special events at 7050 W. Belmont.

4) As many of you know, FR. RICHARD MILEK is our pastor. His mother TERESA died in POLAND 1/3. We will have a MEMORIAL MASS for her JANUARY 27, 7pm. Mass will be interpreted in Sign-Language.

5) “MANAGED CARE”. IF your health insurance is MEDICAID, the State of Illinois will be sending you a letter re: “MANAGED CARE”. Do NOT panic; everyone on Medicaid will get one of the letters eventually. “Managed care” means that the State will ask you to choose a “Managed Care Provider” for your health insurance coverage. 6) Did you sign-up for the Affordable Health Care Insurance in 2014? You may have to check off a special box on your 2014 Income Tax. Go to: www.healthcare.gov/taxes.
