***700 years BEFORE Jesus, the prophet ISAIAH received a vision from GOD.

ISAIAH then wrote about a “Suffering Servant” whose suffering & death would free people from their sins. 700 years later, JESUS became that “Suffering

Servant” to take away our sins by HIS suffering and death on a Cross. There are four (4) “Suffering Servant” predictions. We read them all this week:

ISAIAH 42:1-7...49:1-6...50:4-9...on GOOD FRIDAY, 52:13-53:12.

REMEMBER to bring your Holy Water bottle to church with you SATURDAY or SUNDAY. If you still have some holy water left, pour it out on your plants or grass. Do NOT dump it in the sink.
