## **SOME NOTES FROM FR. JOE:**

1) GUNS. When the police captured the man who murdered Fr. Rene, the police found more than 10 guns in the back seat of the car. Where did the man get these guns? He stole them from homes. Most criminals do not buy guns. They steal them from homes of gun owners.

In the last two months, two children (ages 4 & 6) have killed their mothers who were driving. How? The children reached into the mom's purse, a gun was there. The child pulled the trigger by accident, and killed mom. Guns kill people. If you own a gun you MUST have a FOID (Firearm Owner ID) card. If you own a gun, you must keep it locked up in a safe place. If you have a gun which you do NOT want in your home, call your local police dept, and the police will come to pick it up. If you do not want to call the police, empty the gun, and give the gun and bullets to Fr. Joe. He will give them to the police and not tell them who had the gun.

If you have boxes of old bullets, shells in your home, they are a fire risk. Call the local police dept. to remove the shells from your home.
