SOME NOTES from FR. JOE:

1) *During the last weeks of the Church year (ends 11/26), we are reading from the Book of Revelation, the last book of the Bible. St. John the Apostle probably wrote this about the year 100 AD. This book had two purposes:

I) To challenge the Christian Church communities because people had begun to become lazy in their Faith.

II) To encourage those Christians who were suffering persecution from the Roman Empire because of their Catholic Faith. Don't give up!

St. John uses many images – dragons, fire, water, storms – to emphasize that the forces of GOOD & EVIL are very powerful.

2) TIME to say/sign, “I AM SORRY.” One of the best ways we can prepare for Christmas is going to CONFESSION (Sacrament of Reconciliation). We have a number of opportunities to do this:

➤ SAT, 12/3: Fr. Chris Klusman, NOON-2pm, at St. Francis Borgia.

➤ SUN, 12/11, 3pm: Fr. Joe at St. Julie.

➤ SAT, 12/17, 1-3PM: Fr. Joe, St. Francis Borgia.

Maybe you feel embarrassed to tell your sins to priests who know you. Priests sin, too! Priests have to go to Confession, same as you! I (Fr. Joe), Fr. Roberto, or any of the other priests do NOT judge you or condemn you because of your sins. We are there to give you God's merciful forgiveness.

3) THE ELECTION. I know many people are upset about the Presidential election. We have a responsibility to pray for all those in public office. Pray in a special way for our police officers, fire fighters, paramedics, and those who serve in the military of our country.

4) Next Sunday, after our Mass, we will have another “Rosary Workshop”. These are wonderful times to learn how to pray the Rosary and learn more about God's love.

5) During this time of the year, we attend holiday parties, social events. We have to be careful. If we have several drinks, we should NOT be driving home. Alcohol with a lot of food makes us feel very drowsy. It is easy for us to fall asleep at the wheel or to drive through a red light or STOP sign.
