

How to find the Sunday Readings

1. Go to Readings page of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' website:

2. Go to the Calendar and select the date. *See the red arrow.*

** N.B. If you are a Lector for the 5:00 p.m. Mass on Saturdays, you will need to click on the date for the Sunday.*

3. Read through the First and Second Readings as appointed. You do not need to worry about the Psalm, the Gospel acclamation, or the Gospel.

4. If there are alternative readings (it will say "OR") – you can check with the folded "Music Guide", which tells you which Readings. We will be putting up the Readings for the Sunday, on the Parish website in the future.

5. You can listen to the readings read as an audio file, in order to help with pronunciation. There is also a video reflection on the Readings. *See the blue arrow.*
