7th & 8th Grades

Students should be <u>proficient</u> at all above prayers. By the end of 8th Grade, students should also know the following: The Trinity, The Seven Sacraments, Great Commandment, Ten Commandments, Holy Days, Seasons of the Liturgical Calendar and their Colors, Beatitudes, Moral Virtues, Theological Virtues, Corporal Works of Mercy, Spiritual Works of Mercy, Gifts of the Holy Spirit, Fruits of the Holy Spirit and the Precepts of the Catholic Church.
