



Liturgy Meeting
July 29, 2014
St. Patrick --- Monona

The liturgy committee met with Fr. Nils on Tuesday, July 29th at 6:30 p.m. in the conference room at St. Patrick in Monona. Present for the meeting were: Fr. Nils, Terri Strutt, Linda Bacon, Deb Smith (President), Joanne Enyart, and Julie Heitland (secretary).

Fr. Nils opened the meeting with prayer. The topic of discussion for this meeting was to prepare for Fr. Nils installation masses the weekend of August 30 and August 31. Archbishop Michael Jackels will be present at each of the four (4) masses that weekend to formally install Fr. Nils into each parish for the Trinity Cluster.

Fr. Nils went over the procedure of what will happen during the mass and the order of things. Archbishop Jackels will be present to do the installation. We reviewed one procedure when the Dean and another procedure in the Book of Blessings do it. We will use whichever one the Archbishop prefers. The music was discussed and selected for the day. Each parish and the Hispanic community will provide a reception following the installation. The music for three (3) of the masses will be the same in each parish. The music selected is as follows:

Entrance – Lord of All Hopefulness – all versus to be sung
Preparation – Servant Song
Communion – Taste and See
Sending Forth – Lead Me Lord – all versus to be sung

The service music including the Gloria will also be sung.

It was mentioned about the holy day on Friday, August 15. It is a day of obligation. Fr. Nils will be gone so he will see what he can do to find a substitute and let us know what the schedule will be for masses. The Holy day will have a vigil mass on Thursday night at St. Patrick and the day mass at St. Bridget as that is their regular day for weekday mass.

Fr. Nils would like to have 2 or 3 representatives per parish on the liturgy committee. We will meet the first Thursday of each month at 6:00 at St. Patrick in Monona in the conference room. The first half will be devoted to faith formation as the liturgy is key in forming our faith. Following a break for refreshments, the second half of the meeting will be devoted to liturgy topics and weekend masses. Each parish will take turns bringing treats for the meeting and providing the opening prayer. St. Patrick volunteered to take charge for the next meeting on September 4th. The December meeting will be potluck and some time for socializing. The committee will not meet in June or July as Fr. Nils will be gone to school.

The meeting was closed with prayer. Please mark your calendar for the meeting on September 4th at 6:00 at St. Patrick in Monona.
