

Library Organization

All bookshelves are arranged by subject. Some bookshelves are arranged in ABC order by author or Saint's name.

If you aren't sure where a book you have been looking at belongs, just drop it in the book return basket. One of our library volunteers will be happy to put it back for you.

An easy way to put a book back where it belongs is to use a "shelf paddle." Paddles are "shelf place markers" put here for your convenience. If you decide to take the book home with you simply remove the paddle.

Browse Electronically

Search via Parish Library app "tiny cat" or via the Library Page on the Parish Website.

Tap the image of a book you'd like to locate on the shelf.

Book location (shelf #) are listed under "local notes"

Please Request a Library Card

Fill out a Library Card request located in the **blue box** on the book shelf near the clock. Leave the completed request in the same box.

Please **choose a book** to borrow while waiting for your Library Card to be ready. Simply write the title of the book you are borrowing on the back of the Library Card request.

You may also request a Library Card online via the Library Page on the Parish Website.

Pick up your Library Card

Your Library Card will be waiting for you in the **green file box** on the book shelf under the clock.



Borrow a Book

In the **bright orange folder** fill in:

1. The Date
2. Book Title, or Book bar-code # (Found on the upper left corner of book cover)
3. Your library card bar-code # or name.

Return a Book

Book Return Baskets are located in the hallway across from the library entrance and in the foyer at the entrance of the parish office via the mail slot.
