Dear Parents,

Enclosed is the registration form for the 2016-17 religious education year. Please take a moment and **fill out both sides of the form, correcting any information that has changed.** Any registration not filled out on both sides will be returned as incomplete.

On the reverse side of the form is a place to share your time and talent. **All families are required to share at least 2 hours annually.** The need for help during class times has increased; and with busy schedules entertained by all, it has become necessary for us to mandate service hours for families. One area that we are in desperate need of helpers is during the various class times. We need a minimum of two hall monitors during each session. The job description is extremely easy: pick up attendance sheets and bring them to the office, make sure students who are excused from class can find their way back and deal with Band-Aid emergencies. Otherwise bring your coffee and a book and sit in the hall during your son or daughter’s class. If interested, please check the appropriate space on the back of the registration form and we’ll be in touch as we set up the calendar.

**Below are the codes for days and times classes are offered. Please select the day and time that works best for you and your family.** This information needs to be transferred to the registration form and identified for each child. Some classes fill up faster than others and will close. This is especially true of the Wednesday afternoon classes. Spaces are not guaranteed but filled based on the that date registration forms are turned in.

Just a reminder that in the Diocese of Madison, students generally receive the sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist in 2nd Grade. A **full year** of documented religious instruction must precede this sacramental preparation—meaning that participation in 1st Grade class material is necessary ahead of 2nd Grade sacraments. This is also true for Confirmation students. A full year of Confirmation 1 classes must be completed before continuing on to Confirmation 2.

At HMC, we respect the fact that families are busy with many commitments along with their dedication to have their children present at religious education classes. **And so, our policy is to excuse students from three classes per year after which make-up work needs to be completed.** Please contact the office for more information.
