### Minutes

1. August Minutes were reviewed
2. The Pro-Life Conference on September 25 was attended by approximately 140-150 people. The speakers were both very good and well received. Interest has been shown in placing billboards along the roadside or in the Sioux Falls area.
3. The Parish Hall repair program for the year has been completed. The south roof has been replaced, the hall ceiling has been repaired and repainted while the hall has been repainted. A projector and screen was also installed. Drainage tiles were installed along the north side of the hall so that we have been able to remove the sump pump. The only outstanding issue is the upgrade of software controlling the church's heating system – that is currently stalled.
4. Evangelization:
  - a. The first Family Formation meeting was reviewed. Some positive feedback was reported, otherwise little comment in the community so far.
  - b. The Ignite program for 7<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> grade has also started and has gone well so far. The Corn Maze trip on October 12 and the Youth Conference in Brookings is currently being promoted.

  - d. A Pro-Life movie will be screened at the Parish Hall on Sunday, October 23.
5. The Diocese has issued standard guidelines for the use and rental of parish facilities which we will apply to the rental of the Parish Hall. This will not affect our policy for large events and the ability to hire a licensed alcohol vendor at those events. The new rental agreement and guidelines are available on our website.
6. The parish dress code for weddings was assessed. It was decided to keep it as it is for the coming year and review its application in 12 months.
