Ministry Position Description

Purpose: To proclaim the Responsorial Psalm and lead the congregation in song.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Prepare the assigned music; music is given out 2-4 weeks in advance.
- 2. Cantor has at least 1 rehearsal with the director of music prior to their scheduled Mass date.
- 3. Arrive at least 20 minutes before Mass is scheduled to begin.
- 4. Cantor introduces the first song and leads singing from the front of church.
- 5. Cantors wear attire appropriate as representatives of the entire congregation to visitors and parishioners alike.

Gifts Needed for this Ministry:

- 1. Musical proficiency
- 2. Pleasant and clear singing tone
- 3. Vocal range conducive to parish repertoire
- 4. Punctuality.
- 5. Dependability.

Amount of Time Required:

- 1. All prospective cantors must complete a 15 minute audition.
- 2. Approx. 30 minute rehearsal with music director for each scheduled Mass.
- 3. Attendance at Mass once or twice a month.
- 4. Practice at home when needed.

When Ministry is Performed:

During weekend and Holy Day Masses.

Length of Commitment:

We request a minimum 1 year commitment.

Training Provided:

Beginning cantors will shadow a current cantor until comfortable and familiar.

Cantors will undergo individual instruction with the director of music as needed.

A schedule is provided every month.
