

## **Eucharistic Minister Position Description**

Purpose: To administer the Precious Blood and Body of Christ during Mass. The privilege of bringing the host and cup to those attending Mass is a very powerful sign of our faith and community.

### **Commitment of time**

You can tell us what mass is convenient for you and what days you will be able to serve in this ministry. You can be scheduled infrequently or as often as several times each month. There are opportunities to minister at special Masses and on Holy Days. Ministers of the Eucharist are asked to provide availability for an upcoming 3 month period and are scheduled according to that availability. Once you are assigned a time, we ask that you find a substitute from the pool of ministers if you are unable to keep your commitment.

Arrive at least 15 minutes before Mass is scheduled to begin.

### **Gifts needed for this Ministry**

You should be comfortable interacting with people and able to keep commitments, arrive at mass on time and reverently distribute the Eucharist. You will be trained for approximately 30 minutes. Any age is appropriate starting at high school.

An ability to ascend and descend steps to the altar is required.

Eucharistic Ministers wear attire appropriate as representatives of the entire congregation to visitors and parishioners alike.
