ADORATION:

St. Mary: First Thursday of the month after morning Mass.

St. James: First Friday of the month after morning Mass; Third Sunday of the Month from 4:00-6:00 PM

CONFESSION SCHEDULE:

After weekday Masses at respective Church. Saturday at 3:30 PM at St. James.

Sunday after 10:30 AM Mass at St. Mary.

(Leave a note in Sacristy for Father before Mass if you wish to go to Confessions after Mass)

All Souls Day Indulgence for the Souls in Purgatory:

All Souls Day is a solemn celebration commemorating all those who have died and are now in Purgatory. Purgatory is where the soul waits with great torment for the longing to be with God. Souls in Purgatory cannot offer sacrifice or pray for themselves to be purified, it is up to the living to offer Mass, prayers, fasting & acts of mercy for those who died. "All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven" (CCC 1030)

The Church offers a special plenary indulgence, applicable only to the souls in Purgatory on:

- 1) All Souls Day, November 2, to the faithful who devoutly visit a church and pray an Our Father and the Creed.
- 2) From November 1 to 8, to the faithful who devoutly visit a Cemetery and pray for the departed.

A plenary indulgence

offers the complete remission of all temporal punishment due to sins already forgiven.

One may gain a *partial indulgence*, applicable only to the souls in Purgatory: Throughout the year by devoutly reciting the "Eternal Rest" prayer (see below).

A partial indulgence


speeds up the process of the perfection of a soul, but doesn't promise immediate release.

To Gain an Indulgence, one must:

- * Be in the state of grace, having gone to Confession
- * Receive Communion
- * Pray for the intentions of the Pope

For Plenary indulgence, it is also necessary to have complete detachment from sin, even venial sin.

"Eternal Rest grant onto them O Lord and let the Perpetual Light shine upon them. May they, and all the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen"
