THE CHRISTMAS SEASON

The Christmas Season, also known as Christmastide, extends far longer than just the day of Christmas.

HOLY FAMILY (12-31) - The feast celebration Jesus, Mary and Joseph as the model for Christian families.

MARY MOTHER OF GOD (1-1) – This celebration venerates Mary as the mother of Jesus. **EPIPHANY (1-7)** – The feast of the manifestation of Christ to the world.

BAPTISM OF JESUS (1-8) – This feast marks the end of Christmastide and celebrates the revelation of Jesus' divinity to the Jewish people.

By including the feast of the martyr Stephen, the massacred Holy Innocents, we realize that Christ's incarnation always includes not only acceptance but also rejection and persecution.

ADORATION:

St. Mary: First Thursday of the month after morning Mass. **St. James:** First Friday of the month after morning Mass; First Thursday of the Month 4:30-5:30 PM

CONFESSION SCHEDULE:

After weekday Masses at respective Church. Saturday at 3:30 PM at St. Mary of Mount Carmel. Sunday after 10:30 AM Mass at St. Mary of Mount Carmel.

(Leave a note in Sacristy for Father before Mass if you wish to go to Confessions after Mass)

Sunday, December 24th 10pm at St. James

Monday, December 25th Christmas Day - 10 am St. James

MASS OBLIGATIONS:

Catholics are required to attend Mass every Sunday (or Saturday evening) as well as Holy Days of Obligation. Thus, Attending Mass on Sunday Morning, December 24th fulfills the Sunday Obligation Only. To fulfill the Christmas obligation, you must attend a Christmas Mass.



"DID YOU KNOW" from the Sacred Worship Committee

DID YOU KNOW? From the Sacred Worship Committee I think most of us understand that the season of Advent is the time of preparation for the celebration of the birth of Jesus Christ. It is also a period of mindfulness for the 2nd coming of Christ. What is your PURPOSE for this season? Is your soul prepared to receive Jesus? Is your spiritual house in order? Perhaps you could focus on gratitude towards God at this time. Perhaps your purpose will be contemplative prayer or giving to others. Consider using your gifts of the Holy Spirit, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness and self control to assist you in your readiness. Allow your purpose during Advent to transform you. In the Gospel reading on December 5th, Jesus expressed his gratitude towards his Father. Then... Turning to the disciples in private he said, "Blessed are the eyes that see what you see. For I say to you, many prophets and kings desired to see what you see, but did not see it, and to hear what you hear, but did not hear it." Luke 10:22 How privileged are we to know that Christ came at that time and in that place over 2000 years ago. The Jewish people longed for the coming of our Messiah. How privileged are we to be able to then read of His life in the New Testament. We are blessed. In closing, a beautiful quote from Saint Mother Teresa: "Mark the season of Advent by loving and serving others with God's own love and concern".

MARRIAGE:

Couples requesting the celebration of the Sacrament of Marriage should contact the office at the time of engagement, at least six months prior to the anticipated date of marriage. If a couple wishes to be married as a registered parish member, they must actively participate in the faith (Sunday worship) and be a registered member of our parish at least 3 months prior to requesting the Sacrament of Marriage. Weddings are not celebrated during Lent.

BAPTISM:

Parents may request the baptism of their infant at least two months prior to the anticipated date of baptism. Family should be members of our parish, they must actively participate in the faith (Sunday worship) and be a registered member of our parish. To request baptism, please call the parish office at 715-824-3455.

If you or a loved one is in need of the Anointing Sacrament especially before a hospital stay or procedure - please contact the office.
