

#### FEAST DAYS OF OUR TWO PARISHES DURING THE MONTH OF JULY:

The Feast of "Our Lady of Mount Carmel" was on July 16<sup>th</sup> and was celebrated last weekend at St. Mary. July 25<sup>th</sup> is the Feast of "St. James". St. James will celebrate this weekend with a Litany to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and Benediction following both Masses. On the back cover of our Hymnals, you will find prayers for Our Lady of Mount Carmel and for St. James.

### Facts about Saint Joachim & Saint Anne

- 1. **Patronage:** Are the patron saints of grandparents.
- 2. Feast Day: July 26<sup>th</sup>, parents of Mary.
- 3. **Historical & Legendary Accounts**: Bible does not mention them by name, the stories came from apocryphal texts.
- 4. **St. Anne's Virtue:** A woman of deep faith, patiently enduring years of infertility before the miraculous birth of Mary.
- 5. **St. Joachim's Devotion:** A descendant of King David.
- 6. **Mary's Upbringing:** They dedicated Mary to God at a young age, perhaps at three, following a vow made to God.
- 7. The Birth of Mary: St. Anne's conception of Mary is a miraculous event, celebrating this through the feast of the Immaculate Conception., conceived without original sin, making her the "new Eve".
- 8. **Miracles & Devotion:** They are invoked for healing, especially those who are childless or struggling with family issues.
- 9. **"The Grandparents of Jesus"**: They are called the "grandparents of Jesus, reflecting their intimate connection to the Holy family.

Their lives, carry deep meaning for our faith, especially in promoting the sanctity of family life and the importance of prayer and patience in God's timing.

### MARRIAGE:

Couples requesting the celebration of the Sacrament of Marriage should contact the office at the time of engagement, at least six months prior to the anticipated date of marriage. If a couple wishes to be married as a registered parish member, they must actively participate in the faith (Sunday worship) and be a registered member of our parish at least 3 months prior to requesting the Sacrament of Marriage. Weddings are not celebrated during Lent.

#### **BAPTISM:**

Parents may request the baptism of their infant at least two months prior to the anticipated date of baptism. Family should be members of our parish, they must actively participate in the faith (Sunday worship) and be a registered member of our parish. To request baptism, please call the parish office at 715-824-3455.

### ANNOINTING OF THE SICK:

If you or a loved one is in need of the Anointing Sacrament especially before a hospital stay or procedure - please contact the office.
