

## **FAITH STEP:**

There have been many who have predicted the Second Coming. But what did Jesus say about the date? It was right there in the story of the Ten Virgins:

"therefore, stay awake, for you know neither the day nor the hour" (Matthew 25:13). We should be looking forward to, not something we should be afraid of. If we really love the Lord, we want Him to come back. St. Peter says you should be "hastening the coming of the day of God" (2 Peter 3:12). If you don't then that means you've got a guilty conscience, and you need to get yourself to Confession. Ask the Holy Spirit to make your life holy so that you will want to see Jesus come again. This is something you should be thinking about every day: living each day of your life as if it was your last day on earth.

But of that day or hour, no one knows, neither the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father (Mark 13:32).

#### **MARRIAGE:**

Couples requesting the celebration of the Sacrament of Marriage should contact the office at the time of engagement, at least six months prior to the anticipated date of marriage. If a couple wishes to be married as a registered parish member, they must actively participate in the faith (Sunday worship) and be a registered member of our parish at least 3 months prior to requesting the Sacrament of Marriage. Weddings are not celebrated during Lent.

## **BAPTISM:**

Parents may request the baptism of their infant at least two months prior to the anticipated date of baptism. Family should be members of our parish, they must actively participate in the faith (Sunday worship) and be a registered member of our parish. To request baptism, please call the parish office at 715-824-3455.

## **ANNOINTING OF THE SICK:**

If you or a loved one is in need of the Anointing Sacrament especially before a hospital stay or procedure - please contact the office.
