- We will be attending July 17-22
- This trip is open for students who are currently 6th and 7th graders (will be 7th and 8th graders during the 2023-2024 school year)
- We will depart from St. Mary's around 6am on July 17, 2023, and will return to St. Mary's around 9pm on July 22, 2023
 - o Times are an estimate and are subject to change, parents will be notified of the change and will be kept updated on arrival time back to Mobile
 - o We will be taking a charter bus to and from camp
- Cost of the trip is \$700
 - o This cost includes the cost of camp and transportation.
 - o If you would like part of the fundraising to be applied to your child's cost, your child must help with and attend the fundraising events (more information on this will be given)

- A deposit of \$100 and the liability waiver are due to secure a spot
