FOOD FOR THOUGHT

Mary was a first-century Jewish woman of Nazareth, the wife of Joseph and the mother of Jesus. She is a central figure of Christianity, venerated under various titles such as virgin or queen, many of them mentioned in the Litany of Loreto. The Eastern and Oriental Orthodox, Church of the East, Catholic, Anglican, and Lutheran churches believe that Mary, as mother of Jesus, is the Mother of God.

The New Testament of the Bible provides the earliest documented references to Mary by name, mainly in the canonical Gospels. She is described as a young virgin who was chosen by God to conceive Jesus through the Holy Spirit.

After giving birth to Jesus in Bethlehem, she raised him in the city of Nazareth in Galilee, and was in Jerusalem at his crucifixion and with the apostles after his ascension. Although her later life is not accounted in the Bible, Catholic and Eastern Christian traditions believe that her body was raised into heaven at the end of her earthly life, which is known in Western Christianity as the Assumption of Mary and in Eastern Christianity as the Dormition of the Mother of God.

Para Reflexionar!

La presencia de María es atestiguada por las principales corrientes del cristianismo primitivo que terminaron por integrar el canon bíblico: primero, de forma alusiva, en el cristianismo paulino, y luego, con mayor énfasis en el cristianismo sinóptico y Joánico, donde se la considera una personalidad cualificada y en más de un sentido única, partícipe singular de un momento clave de la Historia de la salvación, la encarnación de Jesucristo, y copartícipe de otros dos, la crucifixión y muerte de Jesús, y la conformación de la primera comunidad cristiana orante inmediatamente antes de la venida del Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés.

El Evangelio de Mateo y el Evangelio de Lucas presentan a María como una joven virgen cuando, en la Anunciación, supo que estaba encinta por obra del Espíritu Santo, sin concurso de varón. Por esto, a menudo se la llama la Virgen María, o simplemente la Virgen, en las Iglesias Cristianas Católica, Ortodoxa y Copta.
