I. Watch a movie about a saint from FORMED.ORG

- Go to <https://formed.org/>
- Press **ENTER CODE**, type **VWCM4F** and follow directions
- Go to link called **WATCH** and choose any movie from section called;
 - Saints of History
 - Modern-Day Saints
 - The Life and Witness of Mary
- After watching a chosen movie write clearly on a sheet of paper
 - Your first and last name
 - Title of the movie
 - How long it was?
 - What was the movie about?
 - What do you like about the movie? Why?
 - What didn't you like about the movie? Why?
 - What did you learn from it?
- Submit completed paper to your PSR teacher. The length of the movie equals the number of hours.
