Things to Know

What: Catholic Heart Workcamp is a national organization that combines service, worship, friendship, and fun in a retreat-like setting. Participants will travel to Charleston, SC, to work, play and pray with other teens from across the nation. The days begin and end with a high energy, motivational program including music, drama, speakers, and prayer. During the day, groups will work on various types of service projects including painting, home repair, light construction, landscaping, working in food banks, assisting in childcare facilities, and more.

When: June 25- July 1

Where: Boston, MA

Who: Students rising into 8th through college, along with adult chaperone (male and female)

How many: We have reserved 15 teen, 5 college age, and 5 adults including myself. More can be added, so long as the CHWC does not fill the week.

Cost: Youth price - \$375; Adult price - \$125

The cost of \$375 includes the \$125 due with this paperwork by Sunday, December 11th to reserve your spot. This cost also includes all lodging (at a local school), meals (except for our travel time and free day), and activities during camp (except our free day. The approximate total for all youth is \$700 which then includes vans, fuel, and t-shirts. This is the reason we have fundraising opportunities available.

Reservations: Your spot is reserved when you have submitted your deposit (\$125) AND you have completed the attached forms.
