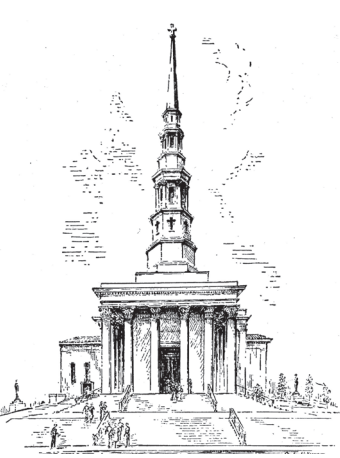

Profession of FaithNicene Creed
