

# **Dismissal procedures**

- \*Children must be picked up by an adult older than 18 years old from Church/Hall or classroom.
- \*Parents are expected to keep control of their children when moving to their car for safety.\*
- \*No child will be allowed to wait outside for a parent. If a child is not picked up 15 minutes after class and parents have not notified us about an emergency more than once Child Protective Services may be called

# Prayers your child should know by Grade

**Kindergarten and 1st Grade:** Sign of the Cross; Glory Be; Lord's Prayer; Angel of God, Hail Mary.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Grade**: Act of Contrition and 10 Commandments, Nicene Creed.

3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> Grade: Apostles Creed, Stations of the cross, Rosary.

Parents need to ensure they practice these prayers at home with their children.

**First Communion and OCIA** Sign of the cross; Glory Be; Lord's Prayer; Angel of God, Hail Mary. Act of Contrition, 10 Commandments and Nicene Creed.

#### **Attendance**

We only have 26 session every year. This is why is so important children attend all sessions. First communion students must not miss classes unless sick and make up the miss class at home with help of parents

# **How You Can Help Your Child Grow in Faith**

Here are several points that will aid you in helping your child grow in his/her faith:

- \* Attend and participate in Sunday Mass as a family.
- \* Participate in special events with the parish such as the patron saint's feast, holiday customs and blessings.
- \* Help your child to learn and participate in various types of prayer (i.e. quiet reflection, guided meditation, song, spontaneous, petition, thanksgiving, praise and sorrow).
- \* Help your child to learn and pray formal prayers: Sign of the Cross, Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be, Prayer before and after meals
- \* Participate in activities for advent and lent to appreciate the significance of these liturgical seasons e.g. advent wreath, stations-of-the-cross for children
