Request a Letter of Good Standing to be a Sponsor

In accepting to be a sponsor for a candidate(s) for the reception of the Sacrament of Baptism or Confirmation, you accept and attest that you are a responsible, committed and active Catholic, who is ready to assist the candidate in living a Christian life, and the candidates(s) parents and family in their practice of the Catholic Faith.

To receive a signed *Letter of Good Standing to be a Sponsor* here at St. Leo, the parishioner requesting the letter is obligated to meet the following requirements:

- 1. Be a registered parishioner of St. Leo Catholic Church.*
- 2. Be at least 16 years of age.
- 3. NOT be a parent of the person being baptized or the candidate for Confirmation.
- 4. Have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Communion.
- 5. Be an active Catholic committed to living a life in accord with Catholic Teaching and Tradition.
- 6. If married, your current marriage must have been witnessed by a Catholic Priest or Deacon.
- 7. Fully participate in the Sacramental life of the Church and are free to receive Holy Communion when you come to Mass.
- 8. Be present to the person being baptized or the candidate for Confirmation and further help the godchild fulfill their baptismal promises faithfully, in accordance with the Holy Spirit.
