## Financial Report for 2022/23

- -- With heartfelt thanks to all, St. Leo's ended 2022 in the black! Our total income of \$828,749 was 8.6% more than in 2021. Our total expenses in 2022 were \$755,832, only a 5.6% increase. This left us with a positive balance of \$72,916.
- -- Be aware, however, that we still owe \$324,410 for our share of the Cathedraticum and Priests' Health and Retirement Association. The Finance Council is working on a plan to repay these amounts so that St. Leo can qualify for loans and grants from the Diocese in the future.
- -- Challenges in 2023 include continuing to fund the repairs needed to restore our facilities to proper condition and filling the choir director position. Thus, in our 2023 budget, our salaries and benefits category as well as our buildings and operations category have been increased.
