


In honor of our Veterans on Memorial Day, OLV Cub Scout Pack 909 will place flags

Pentecost




I have always been interested in how our tradition of great religious art compliments and completes our understanding from the Scriptures. This great feast of Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit fanned the flames of faith into the Church after Jesus ascended into Heaven, is a great example. As important as this

feast day is to the life of the Church, there is not much about it in the Bible. The Book of Acts just tells the story of how the Apostles had to choose the 12th Apostle, to replace Judas Iscariot who betrayed Jesus. They prayed until it became clear that God wanted Matthias to be the 12th and last. Immediately after that, the author records that they were gathered together in an upper room for prayer when the Holy Spirit filled them – and gave them a very dramatic sign. The sounds of rushing wind, and what appeared to be tongues of fire splitting apart and resting upon each one of them, empowering them to speak a special language that foreigners of every stripe could understand.

There is a lot packed into this. The tradition of art tells us more. The Bible doesn't mention her at all, but we assume that Mary was with the Apostles as they received the Holy Spirit. In fact, she is almost always depicted as front and center, sometimes almost enthroned, with the Apostles gathering around her. In some of the art, she is depicted as calmly and demurely looking down, joyful but unsurprised, as if she were expecting this to happen. By contrast, the Apostles are often depicted as astounded, with their eyes raised to Heaven in wonder, sometimes in a gesture of praise or adoration with their hands raised high in the air. This shouldn't surprise us, because this is not the first time that the Blessed Virgin Mary was filled with the Holy Spirit. He overshadowed her at the Annunciation, when she first said Yes to God's proposal to become the Mother of God. To the Apostles, however, this is a brand new encounter with the awesome power, warmth, love, and fiery presence of God Himself.

One of the things the artwork of the Pentecost reminds us of is that the same Holy Spirit works in many different ways in our lives. He is the spirit of unity of course (that's why the Biblical account tells us the One Fire was divided among the Apostles). But He gives us the gifts we need to love and serve God according to our temperament and our state in our spiritual life. To some, He gives a sense of

profound calm and strength even in the midst of extraordinarily trying circumstances: to others He gives a bold and jealous joy to "fire them up" to proclaim the Lord; to others He gives them the wisdom to say just the right thing that will help people know and believe that God Our Father loves us with a love beyond all telling



and that our whole lives center around the saving sacrifice of Jesus' death on the Cross.

We sometimes use the idiomatic phrase, "it was like a light bulb switched on" to describe a sudden flash of insight to see something we just weren't able to see before. That is what the Holy Spirit can do -ifwe pray to Him and ask Him to. We may have been halfheartedly or mechanically practicing our faith for years – even decades – when the Holy Spirit rushes in and reveals to us that what was just "background noise" to us before suddenly becomes the very center and core of the meaning of our lives.

The thing to remember is that the Holy Spirit is powerful! He can do all that and more. On this Pentecost Sunday let's pray that we truly open our hearts to the power of the Holy Spirit.



Feast of Corpus Christi


Please join us on Sunday, June 3rd at 12pm for our Corpus Christi procession at Our Lady of Victory.

What is Corpus Christi?

The Feast of Corpus
Christi (Latin for "Body of
Christ") is the liturgical
celebration of the real
presence of the body and
blood of Jesus Christ, the Son
of God, in the Eucharist—
known as transubstantiation.
Corpus Christi emphasizes the
joy of the Eucharist being the
body and blood of Jesus
Christ.

The feast is liturgically celebrated on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday or, in a place where the Solemnity of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ is not a holy day of obligation, it is assigned to the Sunday after the Most Holy Trinity as its proper day.

At the end of Mass, there is often a procession of the Blessed Sacrament, generally displayed in a monstrance. The procession is followed by Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.


