

#### From the desk of Fr. Ben



"They who sing pray twice" St. Augustine of Hippo

I am very happy to announce that we have appointed a new music director. Elaina McCormick, who has served in our choir for some time as a cantor and musician, will begin her new assignment 1st September 2018. This might be a good time to consider signing up for one of our choirs or music group. The Sacred Liturgy should be the glory of our parish – let's make that a reality.

You might have noticed a new chapel arrangement. With the permission of the Archbishop, I have restored the reservation of the Most Blessed Sacrament to a tabernacle in the Chapel as well as the Church. This is to accommodate those who come every day to pray, but because we lock the Church (for security reasons), the Blessed Sacrament and Tabernacle could only be viewed "through a glass darkly" (1 Corinthians 13:12). Please be sure to visit and pray and spend time with the Lord. For those who cannot come to Church – don't worry – God hears our prayers wherever we are because He is everywhere. I would ask you to pray everyday for the success of our mission at Our Lady of Victory, for our families, our children, parents, married couples, and for your priest.

I have also arranged two new Confession times on Sunday morning: 8:00am – 8:30am and 10:15am 10:45am. This is to accommodate those who can't get to Confession Monday evening or Saturday afternoon, but who can get to Mass on Sunday. With schedules the way they are it can be difficult to make Confession times. I hope this helps. If Confession wasn't necessary Jesus wouldn't have given it to us as His last gift before He went to Heaven. Any psychologist will tell you that regular use of the Catholic Sacrament of Confession is one of the healthiest means to inner peace and a healthy life. It may also lead to the salvation of your soul.

As your new parish priest, I wanted to tell you that I have been very impressed with how many people are active and involved in the parish in so many ways. It's very encouraging to see the level of activity and engagement in Church through ministry: serving, singing, ushers, the cleaning crew, the prayer groups, adoration, the number of people who come to daily Mass, the people who take communion to the home bound and the nursing homes, the art and environment crew, as well as the people providing flowers and beautification of the area in front of the Church, school, and offices. There has been a lot of sport related activities, which not only includes coaching, but grounds cleanup and maintenance, concern for the environment and looking forward to providing for our future needs. It is edifying to see the amount of charitable outreach and the concern for the poor. All around I see "good works" and investment, both reaping the work of previous generations and sowing for the future. It is very impressive. It's part of what makes Victory - Victorious!

Just to give you fair warning: I have a devotion to St. Therese the Little Flower and I will be looking for a large statue, or may commission a large statue, of her for our Church. I also think that candle shrines are important sacramentals (signs or actions that point us to the Holy) and will be getting one for this new shrine. I think parents should teach their children to venerate the Saints and this is a beautiful way to do so.

P.S. St. Augustine probably never wrote "They who sing pray twice."






