To round out 2018, Santa's Express was held on Nov 30 and LOV adopted a family from St Vincent de Paul by providing Christmas gifts from their wish lists.


2019 will bring many of our traditional LOV events as well as the return of a favorite.

## Baby Bottle Campaign 2019


On January 26 & 27, Our Lady of Victory Church will again participate in the Baby Bottle Campaign benefiting the programs of Pregnancy Center West.
