We descend to the Garden of Gethsemane and Basilica of Agony (Church of All Nations), where Jesus agonized the night before his arrest. Mass will be celebrated. We will visit St. Anne's Church, the birthplace of the Virgin Mary, and the Pools of Bethesda. We will also visit the Western Wall, the most holy place for the Jews. Dinner and overnight will be at our hotel in Jerusalem.

DAY 5: JERUSALEM / MT. ZION

(Sat. Oct. 24th) Following breakfast, we will visit Mt. Zion, stopping first at the Dormition Abbey, where Mary fell asleep. Then we will visit the Cenacle Church. Mass will be celebrated. Next, we will visit the Upper Room, Jesus' last meeting with His disciples at The Last Supper. We will also visit St. Peter in Gallicantu, where Peter denied our Lord three times (Psalm 88). Next, we will visit the Israeli Museum to see the model of the Second Temple as it was in the time of Jesus and the Dead Sea Scrolls exhibit. Dinner is on your own to explore one of the many local restaurants. Overnight in Jerusalem.

DAY 6: JERUSALEM: VIA DOLOROSA

In Nazareth, we will visit the Basilica of the Annunciation, where the Word became flesh. We will also visit St. Joseph's Church, where St. Joseph had his workshop. This afternoon we will sail on the Sea of Galilee as was done in the time of Jesus. Dinner and overnight will be at our hotel in Tiberias.

DAY 9: MT OF BEATITUDES / CAPERNAUM / TABGHA / GALILEE

(Wed. Oct. 28th) Following breakfast, we will visit the Mt. of Beatitudes, the location of the Sermon on the Mount. Mass will be celebrated. We continue to the Church of the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fish in Tabgha, commemorating Jesus' miracle of feeding 5,000 men, and the Church of the Primacy of St. Peter, where Jesus appeared to the disciples after the resurrection. After St. Peter's Fish lunch (included), we will continue to Capernaum, where Jesus lived, started his ministry, and performed many miracles. Tonight, we will enjoy dinner at Decks Restaurant on the Sea of Galilee. Overnight at our hotel in Tiberias.

DAY 10: MT. CARMEL / CAESAREA MARITIMA / TEL AVIV / THESSALONIKI

(Thurs. Oct. 29th) After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will travel to Mt. Carmel, where Mass will be celebrated. We will visit Caesarea Maritima, where St. Paul set sail to spread the Good News! Afterward, we will travel to the airport in Tel Aviv for our afternoon flight to Thessaloniki, Greece. Upon arrival in Thessaloniki, we will be greeted by our guide and driver. Dinner and overnight will be at our hotel in Thessaloniki.

DAY 11: KAVALA / PHILIPPI / THESSALONIKI

(Fri. Oct. 30th) After breakfast, we will drive to Kavala, which was once the ancient port of Neapolis (Acts 16: 9-11). This is where St. Paul, Silas,

Luke, and Timothy landed when they reached Europe. After lunch, we drive to Philippi, where St. Paul preached his first sermon and established the first church in Europe. While imprisoned in Rome, St. Paul wrote one of his epistles to the Philippians (Acts 16: 11-40). Here, St. Paul baptized a woman named Lydia, the first convert to Christianity in Europe, in a nearby river (Acts 16:11-15). Mass will be celebrated. We return to Thessaloniki for dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight will be at our hotel in Thessaloniki.

DAY 12: THESSALONIKI / METEORA / KALABAKA

(Sat. Oct. 31st) After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will visit Meteora, a unique World Heritage Site. The Meteora monasteries are built upon immense boulders that dominate the area. We will view stunning Byzantine art and breathtaking landscapes. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight will be at your hotel in Kalabaka.

DAY 13: KALABAKA / ATHENS

(Sun. Nov. 1st) Following breakfast and hotel check-out, we will drive to Athens, the oldest and one of the most glorious cities in the world. We will visit the Acropolis (rock), where we will see the ruins of the Parthenon. We will ascend to Mars Hill, where St. Paul spoke to the Athenians about the one true God (Acts 17:22). Mass will be celebrated. Enjoy some time for leisure and dinner on your own. Overnight will be at your hotel in Athens.

DAY 14: CORINTH / ATHENS

(Mon. Nov. 2nd) After breakfast, we will visit the ancient city of Corinth, where St. Paul spent almost two years evangelizing and working with tent makers Aquila and Priscilla (Acts 18:1-18). Disheartened by the state of the Gentile Church in Corinth, St. Paul was prompted to write four letters while here. Mass will be celebrated. Enjoy some time for leisure before our Farewell Dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight will be at your hotel.

DAY 15: RETURN FLIGHT HOME

After our hotel check-out, we will transfer to the airport to catch our return flight home.

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.
