Words

- Be sealed with the, Gift of the Holy Spirit.
- The external expression of this is through the interchange of the couple with the Church witness, as he elicits their intention, and their consent.
- “God the Father of mercies, through the death and resurrection of his Son, has reconciled the world to himself and sent the Holy Spirit among us for the forgiveness of sins; through the ministry of the Church, may God give you pardon and peace: and I absolve you from your sins in then name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Sprit.”
- I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.
- The Prayer of Consecration that follows the laying on of the hands.
- “Through this holy anointing may the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit. **Amen.** May the Lord who frees you from sin save you and raise you up. **Amen.**
- Within the liturgy, with its institution narrative: “This is my body... this is my blood...”
