

ALTAR SOCIETY 2019 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Purpose: To award the scholarship(s) to those who have been active in serving the parish and who will continue to value that service in their college years and their adult life. Up to two (2) \$500 scholarships may be awarded—must meet minimum requirements (see #4).

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1) A St Joseph's parish high school senior girl member, or female BHSU Newman Center member.
- 2) Current cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher (must submit most current official transcript from high school or college in sealed envelope);
- 3) Will be enrolled in a post-secondary school as a full-time student either at a certified college or certified technical/vocational school of their choice;
- 4) Active participant in St. Joseph's parish, & if a Newman Center member be active in the club, defined as a minimum of approximately two (2) hours of service a month;*
- 5) List the names and contact information for two people who can verify your involvement in the parish;
- 6) Applications must be received by the parish office (or postmarked) by **April 15, 2019**. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

*Service could include, but is not limited to, service as or participation in any of the following: Altar Server/MC, Lector, Usher, Greeter, Music Ministry, Generations of Faith (attendee or volunteer), Edge, Life Teen, Youth Rallies, Vacation Bible School, or helper with any of the miscellaneous Altar Society activities (Fall Dinner, Festival in the Park, Garage Sale, St. Joseph's food pantry responsibilities, kitchen/dining room help for receptions, etc.).
