CORE ELEMENTS OF PREPARATION

<u>POWER</u>- Learning to invite the Holy Spirit to move and work powerfully in our lives through prayer, praise & worship, and participation in the sacraments, especially the Eucharist

LOVE_- Participation in the Works of Mercy

<u>SELF CONTROL</u> - Formation sessions give candidates what they need to grow in knowledge and love of God, faith, and virtue.

Each candidate who comes with an open heart will...

- Develop a deeper understanding of their own identity in Christ, rooted in baptism.
- Develop a deep, personal relationship with Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit.
- Come to a deeper understanding of his or her own vocation within the Church, the Body of Christ.
- Recognize participation in Holy Mass as the source & summit of the Catholic Christian life and orient his or her life towards Holy Mass as the center.
- Experience authentic prayer, praise & worship of God and be empowered to pray in this way on his or her own.

WHAT IS CONFIRMATION?

Confirmation is a beautiful sacrament which completes the work that God began in our souls in baptism! Confirmation is a new outpouring of the Holy Spirit into our souls, strengthening us to live as disciples in the world, to become saints, and to lead others to Christ. This sacrament sets our hearts on fire with the Gifts of the Holy Spirit and sends us out into the world on mission! Confirmation is typically received in the 8th grade in the Diocese of Toledo, but this depends on the readiness of the recipient and his or her openness to God's grace.
