Who are "Registered and Active Parishioners" at St Wendelin Parish?

[Please read this carefully, because it is the basis of the commitment you are making by receiving a scholarship.]

Registered and active parishioners of St Wendelin Parish will qualify for parishioner tuition assistance/scholarship for your children who will attend a Catholic school of your choice by being currently registered and demonstrating active commitment to the parish. "Active commitment" is described in the following two paragraphs:

Because the Eucharist is the Source and Summit of our Faith, and is found at the heart of the Catholic Parish, families receiving financial support from the St. Wendelin Education Foundation will attend weekend Mass regularly and participate with time, talent and treasure in parish life. To seek a Catholic school education, yet miss Holy Mass (the highest thing) and parish life is counterproductive. The St. Wendelin Education Foundation wants your children, now and always, to thrive in their relationship with Jesus Christ and His Church.

St Wendelin families in Catholic Schools will be formed and educated for the sacraments of Baptism, First Reconciliation, First Eucharist, and Confirmation at St Wendelin Parish (*Toledo Diocese Pastoral Policy Handbook*).
