- CGS
  - Goal is to finish the year strong for Level I. A couple of students have been introduced to Level II works.
  - o Mid-term goal: 1<sup>st</sup> Grade students will start Level II next year.
  - The Atrium is moving into a new room (across the hall from STEM lab) in the summer. It will be smaller, but much easier to maintain the works and the space.
  - We are looking ahead to CGS being adopted into the day school. Plans and details to be discussed, decided upon and communicated.
  - O Bonnie is presenting an In-Service to staff in February so that everyone has a good understanding of what CGS is.
- First Reconciliation 30 of 32 families came; 3 of 4 priests made it (there was a snowstorm that day). There was lot of positive feedback from parents on both the service itself and the preparation for it. Families have been receiving resources via email from Gerry in lieu of books. The same will be done for First Communion. Books will be ordered for the class next year.
- Safeguarding has been rescheduled to mid-February due to illness.
- Reconciliation for Grades 3-5 during Lent Father Tim will come in between masses on Sundays to
  offer Reconciliation to the Religious Education kids. We are looking for another priest who can come
  on Monday evening.

Retreat – The options for a retreat were two weekends in December... very unpopular dates. For
those who attended, it went well overall. Students seemed to enjoy it and gave good feedback on

- small group sharing, reconciliation, love letters from parents and "cross the line" activity, respectively. Those that couldn't attend went on other retreats (or are planning to go).
- Middle School parents started to help out during the sessions, which has made a big difference.
- High School is going well. Lea is meeting with other high schools in the area (youth ministers), and looking for best practices. She is putting together a program after gathering information. There are many programs in use, most of which are "customized" by each location/school.
- Mom's Group there are two sessions. Flyers are going into baptismal bags to get the word out.
   One session has babysitting available. They are doing a Lenten program. They want to get in on small group marketing, if there is opportunity.
- Lea would like to do a survey, specifically on desired schedules.
- She would like to have programming for the kids that fulfills a purpose year over year. So that by the time they reach confirmation, they have been purposefully exposed to necessary aspects of faith: scripture, creed, justice and charity, etc.
- A suggestion was to create a Mom's Group "group" in the parish app to send reminders and announcements.

- Sacrament Prep parent meeting for First Communion coming up on February 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>.
- Thoughtful Thursdays are going strong. Currently looking at the Gospels of John and Stories of Divine Mercy. There about a dozen regular attendees.
- Scripture Study on Sunday between masses will resume on February 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- Survey Results were dismal. We have 198 families where the children are not enrolled in Religious Education, or the parish day school. Surveys were sent to each family: 148 via email; 50 via USPS. There were only 2 responses. We need to figure out what to do with these results.
- Men's Ministry Update sessions are starting again next week. We need marketing to drum up more interest.
- RCIA there will be a Rite of Welcome this Sunday at 8:30 mass of candidates to be received into the church at Easter. There is a father and daughter who are both receiving First Communion; the father is also being confirmed. Additionally, we have a new adult Confirmation candidate.
- Gift to Parish a generous parishioner has offered to donate new books to the library!
- Christmas Season Book Give Away 250 copies of "Revisiting the Saints", 50 copies of the Bible, and the remaining stock of "Beautiful Mercy" is out. 400 books were taken in total.
- Parish Mission there will not be a parish mission this Lent. St. Boniface is doing one next year as part of their anniversary celebration and they have invited us to participate.
- Small Groups

- o The Lenten Sessions will be starting soon.
- There is a huddle scheduled for February 13.
- o Last week was training for group leaders. The content was very good.
- O Two more groups are starting up this lent.
- o Gerry is continuing his training.
- Gerry sent out email to set up 1:1 meetings with the Men's Small Group leaders.
- Christian Formation Goals Gerry, Bonnie and Lea developed 1-, 3-, and 5-year goals.

- Tina suggested following the Creed. She taught confirmation classes for years using this model.
- Do we have a marketing committee? If so, can we get flyers for CGS to the Mom's Group?
- Don and Bob were asked if the men in their Men's Groups could personally invite individuals that they know to join?
- It was noted that there is no group for young women to join after Confirmation.
- We are looking for ways to get all of the commissions known. Flyers, posters, announcements after mass, testimonials, The messenger (quarterly newsletter), etc. We need a way to "advertise" our various efforts and events.
- Tina is giving our Committee Presentation in the February All Commission Meeting.
- It was noted there is no description on the website about our commission, just a link to the formation site.
