




Profession of Faith / Apostles' Creed

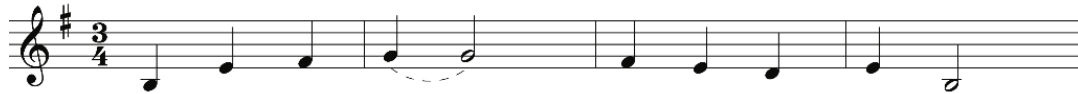
