3. Approve April 10, 2018, Meeting Minutes – Sent to Ann Rodig for posting
4. Father Tim's Report
 - A Communique was received and dispersed from the Archdiocese regarding Father Chuck Hanel. Leadership and Commission groups also received copies.
 - Welcome to Bill Collins for taking over the Trustee Secretary position from Beth Kangas who moved.
 - The attendees for the Amazing Parish Conference October 17-19, 2018 in Milwaukee will be Fr. Tim, Celia Meyers, Dave Braun, George Wiciak and Carol Roltgen
 - Father Tim attended the Spring Assembly of Clergy Monday-Wednesday this past week. The new pastor/administrator for St. Boniface will be Father Mike Petrie. He is presently the pastor of Sacred Heart in Horicon, and the administrator of Saint Matthew in Neosho. Father Petrie was ordained in 1987
 - Saint Gabriel School is presently recruiting for two teaching positions: 3rd grade, and a middle school science/math teacher
 - Faith Formation is recruiting for a new youth leader position as Nick Scanlan has resigned his position. Dave Braun will be heading this up
 - Update by Dave Braun re: Small Groups. Partnering with Evangelic Catholic and using the Sunday scriptures as the focus for the meetings of small discipleship groups during this past Lenten Season. 12 leaders were trained, yielding 7 groups with about 72 people participating. Anticipating starting up again in fall with the present leaders starting new groups of discipleship and training of 5-7 new leaders.

- Clare, the Faith Formation director from Saint Boniface, has been invited to partner with, and grow these small groups in the fall with attendance from across both parishes for another session of 20 weeks. Dave did express concern over not expanding too quickly with the program, which could set them up for failure. He will be attending a “Called and Gifted Workshop” on September 22, 2018.

 - Budget is in the preliminary stage, dealing with school enrollment numbers increasing or decreasing
 - We are down \$25,000 in revenue and hoping to close that gap by end of the fiscal year. We are where we expected to be with expenses.
