2020 Time and Talent Survey Highlights

- 114 total respondents to the survey (either individuals or couples)
- 33 were new individuals/couples who were not previously involved
- The individuals/couples already involved filled 366 individual volunteer roles
- Each person/couple took on an average of 4.4 roles (7 people/couples took on more than 10 each with 20 as the maximum)

75 individuals/couples (both current and new volunteers) indicated interest in 236 new individual roles which were broken out as follows:
