

Some important notes for this year

Service Hours: At this point in the year, I will not be collecting service hours but I would still encourage parents to keep having the children do good works and service for you and family members as much as possible. We can all really use a lot more kindness.

Sacramental Preparation Meetings & Retreats:

Diocesan policy requires that students preparing to receive the sacraments of **First Reconciliation, First Eucharist and Confirmation** attend a retreat. Parents of youth in grades 2, 3, and 11 are expected to attend an informational meeting, as well. These dates will be announced as soon as possible.

For Cancellations or Bad Weather Conditions:

If case of inclement weather, cancellations will be reported on the Erie TV channels: WJET (4), WICU (6), and WSEE (8). Typically, we follow the local school schedule. If the Titusville Area schools cancel or have early dismissal due to weather, faith formation will be cancelled. Cancellation notifications will be sent via REMIND app or text message, as well. Attendance Policy / Make-Up Work:

Attendance at religious instruction classes is very important. In the event of an absence, please call the office to inform us that your son/daughter will not be there. If your son/daughter misses a session, please see your child's catechist to receive information for completing the make-up at home.

Please note, according to diocesan policy, if a young person misses 3 or more sessions in a year and does not complete the required make-up work, he/she will not be able to advance to the next grade level.

Tardiness / Early Dismissal:

Children/youth should make every effort to be on time and to stay for the entire class time. If a young person arrives late, he/she must sign in before going to his/her classroom. Parents/ guardians must submit a signed note if a child is to leave early.

This year more than ever email will be the most used method of communication. Please make sure the address you give me is the best choice and easy to check. If you change your email address during the course of the year, please let me know.
