GENERAL INFORMATION

REGISTRATION: Registration is required for participation in our *Preschool – Grade 5 Children’s Ministry*. It is mandatory for us to have your child’s contact information, health concerns, and signed waivers on file in order for you to leave your child in our care. We now use an online paperless registration service. To register, please follow the link on the parish website – www.ourladyofgracechurch.org. **Registrations are due by August 31, 2021.**

COST: We are requesting a donation of **\$25** for **one** child, **\$50** for **two** children or **\$75** for **three or more** children registering from the same family in order to help defer the cost of materials. There is a link on the website to pay your donation online, or you may mail or drop off a payment to the Parish Office. *Please include your child’s name with the payment.*

SESSION TIMES / LOCATIONS: Children’s Ministry is open to all registered children in preschool through fifth grade. Children in **Grades 2 – 5** will meet *downstairs* in Shepherd’s Hall from **9:00 a.m. – 10:15 a.m.** Children in **Preschool – Grade 1** will meet *upstairs* in Albanese Hall from **10:15 a.m. – 11:30 a.m.**, during the 10:30 a.m. Mass. You will need to come into the hall to **sign your child in and out**, but you will **not** need to stay for the session. Please be sure to arrive a few minutes early so that we can begin on time, and **return promptly at the end of the session** to avoid undue stress on your child and our leaders.

ATTENDANCE: Please make every effort to have your child attend our bi-monthly sessions, *especially during the year prior to and the year of the reception of the Sacraments*. If your child is ill, the session materials will be available for you so that you can cover the content at home before the next session. COMMUNICATION: Regular communication and reminders regarding Children’s Ministry sessions and events will occur through Flocknote. If we need to cancel one of our sessions for any reason, we will also notify you in this manner, so please check your email often.

OPPORTUNITIES TO SERVE: Do you enjoy working with young children? If so, we would love to have you serve as a **small group leader** or **assistant** during our Children’s Ministry sessions! All lesson plans and materials are provided. We can also use helpers to prepare materials at home, as well as volunteers willing to assist with getting the rooms ready before and after each session.
