

Your Patron Saint

A saint is someone who has succeeded struggling through life in union with the will of God. He/she now lives in the presence of God experiencing eternal Trinitarian Love in heaven. The church deems that one who has passed away is a saint usually after there have been 3 proven miracles through the intercession of this saint.

When you are confirmed, you are given the chance to choose a saint who will be a guide and a friend through the events of your life. Through the example of his/her life and through his/her prayers, your patron saint will bring you into a deeper relationship with Christ.

How to choose a patron saint. The church celebrates the feast days of these holy men and women throughout the year. If you were born on or close to the feast day of this saint, you may have been named after him/her. Examine the life of the saint you are named after. 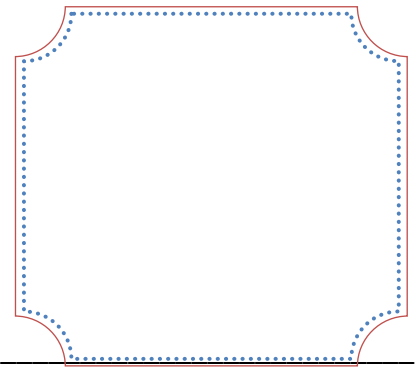
